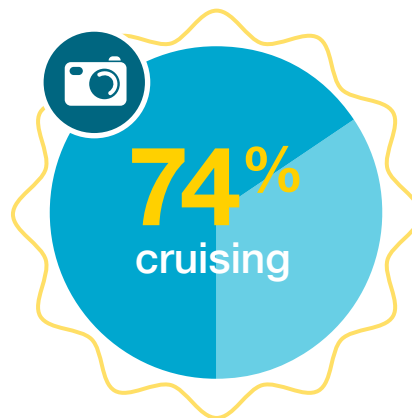


Chart a Course to Safe Boating
